2017 Great Lake Shake

On Friday, December 15, 2017, Lakewood Catholic Academy hosted the first Annual Great Lake Shake Competition for our sixth grade saints. The event was an opportunity for students to use their manners and conversational skills with business professionals and Cleveland area leaders. Students were evaluated on their ability to give a proper handshake, use eye contact, and present themselves in a professional manner.



Our First Annual Great Lake Shake Competition featured three preliminary rounds of competition:

1. Breakfast with Educational Leaders in Cleveland including the Presidents of St. Edward High School, St. Ignatius High School, St. Joseph Academy and Magnificat High School, as well as with the Superintendents of the Cleveland Diocese.
2. Mix and Mingle with Business Professionals in an LCA designed Art Museum
3. Speed Meet & Greet with Cleveland Area Leaders

At the conclusion of the three rounds of competition, judges' scores identified the top six students as finalists: **Abby Brocklehurst, Annabella DeFrasia, Maren Jacobs, Eleanor Mitchell, Cole Trainor, and Samantha Warzocha**. These six students then traveled to the Browns Training Facility and Executive Offices and were interviewed for a marketing position by Mrs. Dee Haslam, owner of the Cleveland Browns. Mrs. Haslam chose our two champions, **Annabella DeFrasia and Eleanor Mitchell**. We celebrated these students at a school assembly where the founders of the Ron Clark Academy announced their victory. Annabella and Eleanor then represented LCA at the National Amazing Shake Competition in Atlanta. At that competition, Eleanor was a finalist and placed 13th in the nation!

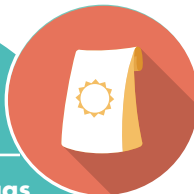
