## REGISTRATION IS OPEN!

LCA's Saints' Spirit Days Summer Camp is ready for summer and ready to welcome your child(ren) to our program, featuring exciting weekly themes and activities to help create adventure-filled summer memories!

The 12-week program offers a unique theme each week, featuring daily activities that engage campers and encourage new experiences. Families can choose to register for full weeks or individual days. Space is limited to the first 50 campers per day. Register by April 17 to save \$10 on your registration fee (\$50 per family if registered by April 17; \$60 per family after this date).

Our program is run by a caring and qualified staff that plans meaningful and engaging activities, field trips and time with friends. All staff members are trusted individuals who are Virtus trained, certified in CPR and First Aid and have undergone background checks and fingerprinting. By limiting camp registrations to the first 50 campers per day, we are able to maintain a camper to staff ratio of 10 to 1, ensuring personal attention for each camper, every day.

## SAINTS' SPIRIT DAYS SUMMER DAY CAMP

**WHAT:** A day camp opportunity, featuring weekly themes with fun activities and projects, field trips, swimming, snacks and more!

**WHEN:** Offered on weekdays for 12 weeks, beginning on Wednesday, June 10th and ending on Friday, August 21st, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. ***On Monday and Tuesday, August 24 and 25, camp ends at 3:00 p.m.***

**WHERE:** On the campus of Lakewood Catholic Academy, 14808 Lake Avenue. Activities held in LCA's renovated After Care space; regular playtime on the LCA campus grounds; visits to Lakewood Park and Foster Pool; field trips to various sites.

**WHO:** Children who are entering Kindergarten through 8th grade as of the beginning of the 2020-21 school year are eligible to attend. Space is limited. 50 spots are available for each session, and children will be added to the program on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority will be given to current LCA families (including families registered to begin classes at LCA in fall 2020).

**COST:** Non-refundable fees are \$200 per full week or \$50 per day, plus a one-time \$50 non-refundable registration fee per family (\$60 after April 17).

- A 10% discount will be given for each additional child within a family when registering for a week-long session. No multi-child discount will be applied when registering for individual days.
- LCA families will be billed on a monthly basis.
- Non-LCA families must pay in advance.

Families must purchase a summer pool pass through the Lakewood Recreation Department for each registered child for Saints' Spirit Days. If a pool pass is not purchased, families must send \$8 per child in cash each week. Field trips, transportation to/from field trips and snacks are included in camp fees.

**HOW TO REGISTER:** Complete the Registration form and Automatic Payment Authorization form and submit both with a one-time, non-refundable \$50 registration fee per family to the LCA Main Office by April 17. After April 17, the registration fee increases to \$60 per family. Note that once registered, completion of additional forms will be required for field trips and emergency treatment authorization.

**SPACE IS LIMITED:** Each weekly camp will be limited to the first 50 fully-registered campers who have paid the deposit. In cases where last-minute care is needed, participation will be subject to space availability. In these cases, the registration fee and all forms must be submitted before the camper can attend. The regular payment schedule will apply (see Payments).

### WHAT IS A DAY AT LCA'S SUMMER CAMP LIKE?

The typical day will combine varying theme-based activities with daily routines that campers can count on during their time with us. Here is a sample daily schedule:

<b>8:00 – 9:00 a.m.</b>	Drop-off & quiet time
<b>9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.</b>	Theme-based activities led by instructors specializing in each topic
<b>12:00 – 1:00 p.m.</b>	Lunch
<b>1:00 – 3:00 p.m.</b>	Games; outside play; swimming; visits to Lakewood Park or Lakewood Library
<b>3:00 – 4:00 p.m.</b>	Snack and clean-up
<b>4:00 – 6:00 p.m.</b>	Pick-up and free time

Schedules may vary from day to day to accommodate scheduled field trips and to allow some flexibility with activities. Morning, lunchtime and afternoon prayer will also be a part of each day.

*\*Cost of camp for Week 1 is \$150.*

*\*\*Cost of camp for Week 12 is \$100. Camp ends at 3:00 p.m. on these two days.*

# PAYMENTS

**REGISTRATION FEE:** A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per family is due upon enrollment in the program. If enrolled after April 17, the registration fee increases to \$60 per family.

**WEEKLY AND DAILY CAMP FEES:** Fees can be paid by automatic withdrawal from your bank account or by check. Payment by automatic withdrawal is encouraged. Fees are due by the 15th of the following month during which your child attends any full or partial camp weeks.

- **Payment by automatic ACH withdrawal:** You will receive a monthly notice of your scheduled payment; your account will be debited for fees on the 15th of the month following your child's attendance at camp.
- **Payment by check:** You will receive a monthly invoice; payment by check is due in the Summer Day Camp Office by the 15th of the following month during which your child attends camp.

## REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

Please be sure to submit all of the items below to complete your registration. Campers are not considered enrolled until all materials are received by LCA.

- Registration form
- \$50 non-refundable deposit per family (\$60 after April 17)
- Automatic Payment Authorization form (if choosing automatic withdrawals)
- Field Trip Permission form & Lakewood Park Permission form
- Emergency Medical Authorization

## WHAT TO BRING

- Packed lunch each day (marked with camper's name) and refillable water bottle
- Wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing, socks and tennis shoes. Flip flops or sandals should not be worn, except on swimming days, which will be planned in advance
- Swim suit, towel, sunscreen and pool pass in a bag or backpack for each swimming day
- Necessary medication (with appropriate parent and/or doctor authorization)
