

STUDENT NOTIFIED OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Parent notifies LCA by calling the main office at 216-521-0559 or emailing COVID@lcsaints.com.



Student quarantines according to current CDC and CCBH guidelines:

- If the student develops symptoms, the student quarantines until he/she is fever free without medicine for 72 hours, 10 days from symptom onset, AND other symptoms have improved.
- If the student has no symptoms, the student quarantines until 14 days have passed since exposure AND symptoms do not develop.



The Division Coordinator will:

- Notify all families in the student's homeroom.
- Ensure areas the student entered are properly sanitized.

The Nurse will keep in touch with family to monitor the student's health/case.

STUDENT SHOWS SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

If off campus, parent notifies LCA by calling the main office at 216-521-0559 or emailing COVID@lcsaints.com. If on campus, the student is sent to the Nurse, who will isolate the student and contact the main office and the parents.



Student quarantines according to current CDC and CCBH guidelines:

- Until he/she is fever free without medicine for 72 hours, 10 days from symptom onset, AND other symptoms have improved.

- Notify all families in the student's homeroom.
- Ensure areas the student entered are properly sanitized.

The Nurse will keep in touch with family to monitor the student's health/case.

STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Parent notifies LCA by calling the main office at 216-521-0559 or emailing COVID@lcsaints.com.



Student quarantines according to current CDC and CCBH guidelines:

- If the student develops symptoms, the student quarantines until he/she is fever free without medicine for 72 hours, 10 days from symptom onset, AND other symptoms have improved.
- If the student has no symptoms, the student quarantines until 10 days have passed since the positive test AND symptoms do not develop.



The Division Coordinator will:

- Gather contact tracing information and call CCBH.
- Notify students and staff required to quarantine based upon exposure.
- Notify the entire school community of the positive test.
- Ensure areas the student entered are properly sanitized.

The Nurse will keep in touch with family to monitor the student's health/case.
