5th grade

Fifth grade marks a student's transition from the primary years to the middle years at LCA. This transition comes with added responsibility and independence but is overseen by LCA's talented and dedicated middle school teaching team. Fifth grade is also a student's first exposure to the House System, which fosters teamwork, collaboration, and leadership in grades 5-8.















6th grade In sixth grade, students participate in LCA's Great Lake Shake, an interpersonal skills competition that connects students to business, school, and community leaders from across Northeast Ohio in an expanded network of learning. Students are judged on their handshakes, eye contact, table manners, and conversation styles and skills as they vie for one of two top spots in the competition.

Later in the year, Arguably the Best introduces students to the use of propaganda and persuasion, in addition to the art of debate. Students work with a partner to research the affirmative or negative side of an assigned topic, then take to the stage and compete against each other in a debate. Arguably the Best encourages students to use their voice, formulate their ideas, and speak persuasively to an audience.

7th grade By the time students enter seventh grade, they are prepared to explore entrepreneurship for nearly an entire semester. Working closely with LCA's Design Teacher and a group of esteemed professionals from the wider LCA community, students work through the ideation process, create a product or service, brand it, then pitch it to a panel of judges at our annual Saints Startup competition. Not only is prize money up for grabs, but so is



the opportunity to move on to local and regional competitions for those students with the best and brightest ideas.

In both their theology and communications classes, our seventh grade saints learn about the powerful influence of persuasive rhetoric and the ability for an individual voice to change the world. They research a notable speaker of their choice, then learn a portion of one of their public speeches. The students memorize the speech and work on communication skills such as articulation, clarity, inflection, and body language all in preparation of taking to the Foster Theater stage at the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame to deliver the speech for our **Prophetic Voices** presentation.






