CELEBRATING INCLUSION: LCA'S COMMITMENT TO BEING A NO PLACE FOR HATE SCHOOL

LCA demonstrated our commitment to inclusion through a year-long effort. We were honored when we received the news of our official designation as a No Place for Hate School from the Anti-Defamation League. LCA joins over 1,800 schools nationwide who successfully completed a series of projects to promote dialogue and engage in active learning about bias, bullying, inclusion, and allyship.

"This program was a wonderful opportunity for student leaders in eighth grade to develop and demonstrate leadership skills while also committing to Catholic principles of peace, justice, and equality," commented Paula Fitzgerald, Director of Mission & Ministry. "Middle school student leaders embraced the chance to return to their kindergarten classrooms and read books about kindness and inclusion. Their enthusiasm inspired us to launch a 'Book of the Year' program in which each of the primary classrooms was able to choose a book related to a NPFH theme. LCA invested in classroom and library copies of each book as one way to ensure that our values will continue to be promoted and discussed."

LCA intentionally chose the Advent Retreat and Catholic Schools Week to implement two of the required projects in order to more directly connect the goals of NPFH with our Catholic identity. Projects were also integrated into the curriculum. As a "May we lead with kindness and make our school, our Church, and our world *No Place for Hate.*"

response to reading *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*, fifth grade students led the effort to create more than 1,000 paper cranes to promote peace, and teachers facilitated discussions about practical ways to make LCA a place **for** peace.

For the culminating project, middle school students focused on allyship and identified strategies to utilize if they witness bullying behaviors in the community. Students also reflected on allyship through grade level experiences at the Maltz Museum and Prophetic Voices. Finally, LCA introduced a new unit in eighth grade theology focusing on Just Mercy and the life and legacy of Bryan Stevenson, justice advocate and consummate upstander.

LCA is heartened by the recognition from the ADL and is committed to exploring new ways to continue to live our mission to be an inclusive and welcoming community and promote peace and justice for all – at LCA and beyond.




A REFLECTION ON THE FIRST 20 YEARS OF LCA

No matter when I come to LCA and see the brightly painted walls, the School of Fish in the main hall, and the television monitor that streams the highlights of student activities, I can't help but remember that day: July 1, 2005 when, after months of dreaming and planning, we were handed the keys to 14808 Lake Avenue and the real work of creating our new school began. For seven weeks that sweltering summer, volunteers from St. Luke, St. Clement, and St. James, along with parents, students, faculty, and alums worked around the clock to transform the building from a high school nearly 100 years old into a bright and shiny elementary school that would welcome new Saints at the end of August.

I'll never forget the gym that was piled 10-15 feet high with desks and boxes of books that were waiting to find a new home in the building; the library books from the three parish schools that sat on the floor of the old library as the high school books still had not been removed; the dedicated teachers who sifted through materials, hoping that their classroom treasures had survived the move across town.

Gradually, over those seven weeks, Lakewood Catholic Academy was born and with it, a new community. In the midst of window glazing, painting, heavy lifting, and washing lockers, volunteers discovered that others shared their same passion — to create a strong and vibrant Catholic elementary school in the City of Lakewood where






children could flourish. In the words of one of our founding pastors, Father Al Winters, "good enough" would no longer be "good enough."

For the past 20 years, our community has been blessed with a steady supply of passionate people who have dared greatly to ensure that Lakewood Catholic Academy would never be just "good enough." Posters and banners that now proclaim LCA as an International Baccalaureate World School, a Blue Ribbon School, and a Green Ribbon School, along with other prestigious awards, can be spotted everywhere in the building and on campus.

Our renovated gymnasium today hosts not only PE classes, but also student performances and competitions, as well as diocesan CYO games.

Our digitally catalogued, sunlit library is visited regularly not only by students in kindergarten through eighth grade, but also by our smallest Saints who are part of our Early Childhood Program.

Our faculty members, who were instrumental in LCA being named a Top Work Place, challenge themselves daily to create engaging lessons to ensure that the needs of all of the 700+ children who come to campus every day are met.

Never could I have imagined on that blistering hot summer day in July 2005 that LCA would, in less than 20 years, become the premier Catholic elementary school in Northeast Ohio. Father Winters' instruction to be better than "good enough" has guided us for the past 20 years and will continue to inspire and challenge us, I know, for the next 20 years and beyond.

CHAMPIONING STUDENT-CENTERED LEARNING

This past November, members of the LCA administrative team proudly accepted the award for being named a U.S. Department of Education National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. This award was given based on an application that highlighted LCA's high standardized test scores, rigorous curriculum, as well as the professionalism of our dedicated staff. Additionally, LCA's commitment to honoring childhood was essential to receiving the Blue Ribbon status. Student access to extracurriculars such as athletics, theatre, arts, and other clubs, as well as the partnerships we foster with parents and other community members, result in a balanced student experience.

Our principal, Brenna Warrell, said "LCA was honored with this award because we are focused on student-centered learning and innovation. Our talented teaching staff make learning fun by bringing magic to the classroom in small ways every day, or in big ways during our classroom transformation days. I am proud of what our school community accomplishes each and every day and am grateful that it has been recognized on a national level."

This past year, LCA welcomed an international team of educators who served as the International Baccalaureate Organization's re-accreditation team. Their task was to evaluate LCA's IB Middle Years Program that impacts teaching and learning in grades six through eight. The team attended classes, interviewed students, teachers, administrators and community members, and reviewed dozens of documents. LCA received commendations for a variety of practices and policies, including our approach to helping students grow in 21st century skills and execute personal inquiry projects. — -continued on page 21


