Fiction Assignment

Nonfiction Assignment

Students will learn about animals as part of a first-grade science unit. Please choose at least two nonfiction books about animals to read with your child.

Your child should write one fact he/she learned from the nonfiction books read this summer and illustrate it. These will be shared in class during the first week of school.
